

**STORMWATER ADVISORY BOARD
REGULAR MEETING
WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 18, 2020**

Members Present: David Joseph Señeres, Stormwater Program Manager; Vicki Fletcher, Stormwater Advisory Board Member, Tommy Hazelwood, Stormwater Advisory Board Member; Members not present had confirmed delays and conflicts via text messaging.

Item 1. Call to Order.

Vicki Fletcher called the meeting to order.

Item 2. Acceptance of the Minutes from August 12, 2020 based on e-mail responses to Online Portal.

Tommy Hazelwood made a motion to approve the minutes; Ryan Campbell seconded the motion; motion was approved unanimously.

Item 3. Notices, Petitions, People to be Heard.

David Joseph Señeres introduced Mr. Ryan Campbell and Ms. Julie Campbell of 220 Aldridge Road who recently moved from the City of High Point to the City of Archdale. Mr. Ryan Campbell described his observations along the existing State Right-Of-Way of Aldridge Road.
