



Tee Ball Rules

1. The games will consist of 2 innings of baseball or a 45 minute time limit. Every player must play in the field. Every player will bat every inning regardless of the number of outs that the defense gets. The batting lineup can change every inning. The last batter will run around all the bases to end the inning regardless of if he/she is out.
2. Each player will be pitched a maximum of 3 balls from his/her coach. If the player does not hit a pitch, then the coach will put the ball on the tee and let them hit.
3. There is no score kept for any tee-ball game.
4. **Beginning the 4th game of the season**, players who are called out will be removed from the bases, however the team will continue to bat until they complete their lineup.
5. The coaches will officiate these games. Coaches are not allowed to touch the ball when it is put into play. Please let the players make the play.
6. When the ball is put in play by a hitter the defense can stop the runners from advancing by tagging them out, a put out at a base or by calling time out. The defensive player must be inside the base paths to call timeout. If a runner is halfway to the next base when time is called, he/she will continue to advance to that base.
7. There will be a circle where 1 player can stand on defense, this player must remain in this circle until the ball is put in play and must wear a helmet with a facemask on it. All other defensive players must play behind this player.
