



QUESTION: I HAVE ITEMS AT THE ROAD, WHY AREN'T THEY GETTING PICKED UP?

ANSWER: The trash service that the City of Archdale contracts with uses an automated system with a single driver. The driver cannot get out of the truck to pick up items that are not in a trash container.

QUESTION: So...what do I do with these items?

ANSWER: Great question! Here are some solutions:

- **Bring it to a local landfill:**
 - Randolph County: 3597 Old Cedar Falls Rd, Randleman (30 minutes away). Household items can be dropped for **FREE** and the facility is open **8am-4:30pm M-F and 7am-12pm Saturday**. They accept household items and many electronics.
 - High Point (336-883-3435): 3940 E Kivett Dr, High Point (15 minutes away). Household items can be dropped off for a fee of about **\$7-20** and the facility is open **7:30am-4:30pm M-F and 7:30am-1pm Saturday**. They accept household items.
 - **Got computers, TVs, or other electronics?** These can be brought to the Recovery Facility at 5875 Riverdale Dr in Jamestown (15 minutes away). Call 336-883-3623 for details.
- **Contact a local junk removal service (often will charge a fee by weight)**
